Dear Store Operator Member,

Since 1990 the Great Lakes Ice Cream + Fast Food Association (GLIC+FFA) has sponsored the Ward J. Anderson Scholarship Program for your student employees. This next year, 2027, GLIC+FFA will award a total of \$3,500 in scholarship monies. Three (3) scholarships are available; one (1) \$1,500 Ward J Anderson Memorial scholarship sponsored by GLIC+FFA, one (1) \$1,000 scholarship sponsored by Michigan Electro Freeze, and one (1) \$1,000 Dick Warren scholarship sponsored by NEICRA.

To be eligible, student employees must:

- Be a high school senior through college seniors (their 4th year of college in a five-year program)
- Work a minimum of three (3) months for a GLIC+FFA store operator member within this year
- A minimum 3.0 GPA at the time of applying
- Plan to attend a college, university, or an accredited trade school as a full-time student in the Fall of 2027

All eligible applications are read and scored by a committee of three (3) Supplier Members of the Board of Directors. The highest scoring applicant will receive a \$1,500 scholarship. The next highest scoring applicants will receive scholarships for the remaining amounts. In the event of any tie in scoring, a random drawing will be held to break the tie. Biographical information and photo are requested to be used for press releases.

The Association will present certificates to the scholarship recipients and their sponsor at the Annual Convention in February. All scholarship winners are asked to personally accept their scholarship certificate *currently* or to accept by a delegate (parent or employer) or video. A check from Great Lakes Ice Cream and Fast Food Association will be issued and sent to your college/university or trade school on your behalf in August 2027. Winners must provide your student ID number and mailing address for payment to be issued.

We are proud to be able to offer these scholarships and are confident our members will continue to see the many benefits of this program. This is a membership benefit to assist members in competing for the best employees in the labor market. The scholarship program will help deserving students meet college/trade school expenses. Finally, the Association and its members will receive a great deal of publicity and goodwill from the communities where we live.

Previous winners are not eligible.

In addition to having worked a minimum of three (3) months during the past year for a GLIC+FFA store operator member, student employees must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be high school seniors through college seniors (their 4th year of college in a five-year program), and plan to attend a college, university, or accredited trade school as a full-time student in the Fall of 2027.

Because the GPA is an important eligibility requirement, it is essential that the GPA be computed uniformly. We are using a 4.00 for the top grade. If your school uses 4.40 for an A+, or weighs the GPA for honor classes, **please adjust the GPA to 4.00 for the top grade.**

All applications and required documents must be completed and emailed to info@glicffa.org by 11:59pm November 1, 2026. Selections are made mid-December and all applicants are notified of their status. The Association presents certificates to the recipients and their sponsors at the Annual Convention in February. Scholarship checks are awarded to the recipient in August following the convention. Previous winners are not eligible.
